## College Magazine

- The College "Publication" will be included as a laboratory in writing under the Literature Division, as is the case of similar laboratory and studic activities in other major fields.
- (2) The Fublication is to be defined as a literary-graphic arts product representing the best written work of all majors, furnishing an audience for the best creative, critical and expecteory writing done by the students. As in the case of art exhibits, musical and dramatic performances, faculty work may also be included.
- (3) Beginning next fall the magazine will be printed, care given to its improvement in appearance, and a more attractive name selected. Two numbers will be issued during the next College year.
- (4) The arrangements for printing and distribution to the community and to graduates, the contracts for publication will be in charge of the faculty Committee on Publications on which faculty members in the fields of Literature and Graphic Arts are always represented.
- (5) It is recommended that Paragraph D, Section I, of the Organization of the Zennington College Community, referring to the Editorial Found, be amended so that the last sentence will read: The Board shall submit its nominees for new Board members to the Literature Division and to the Community Council for approval before election.
  - (6) It is recommended that the present Board submit detailed plans for policy, organization and operation of the improved magazine to the Literature Division and to the Committee on Publications, in the fall.
