I will be up from N.Y. next Tuesday (late) and will start removing the shows early Wednesday. Not one of my 13 students (not to mention any one

of the Visual Arts faculty) has volunteered any help. Marge & I have not made arrangements yet, but 1 or 2 students and I will be driving the works to N.Y. (When ??)
