Dear Mr. Cameron:
I have forwarded a copy of your letter of October 18, 1982 to Mr . Robert Huot. I have just completed a conversation with Mr. Huot, wherein he states that the prhotograph was a gift to him by Mr. Robert Morris, the author of the photograph, and that the same was taken approximately twenty years ago, and the subject is Mr. Robert Huot in costume.

At the time that you requested to borrow the photograph, Mr. Huot stated certain conditions which had to be met:-
(1) That the photograph was merely on loan and had to be copied immediately so that the original and the negative could be returned to Mr. Huot.
(2) In the event that the photograph was used in any publications, full credit had to be given to Mr . Robert Morris for making the photograph.

Mr. Huot states that you failed to comply with these conditions and that he has been forced to take legal action to obtain property, i.e.,' the photograph and the negative. $H_{c}$ is directing me to state that your letter of October 18, 1982 is a total fiction and that $I$ am to send copies of this response to Mr. Robert Morris and Wendy Perron, in order to clarify the record.

Mr. Huot has also directed me to obtain a statement signed by you to the effect that neither you nor any of your associates have any form of the photograph remaining in your possession and, in the event that you do have, they must be returned immediately via this office to Mr . Huot.
