Bennington, Vermont - February 21 - "The Silo", a new literary-graphic arts magazine, will make its appearance at Bennington College at the opening of the second semester on Monday. It is to be published twice a year, and will serve as a laboratory and audience for the writing done by students in the same way that the drama workshop performances and music recitals do in other fields. Although the magazine is to serve especially the literature division and will set up literary standards for acceptance, it will contain the best written work in other fields than literature, and contributions from the faculty will at all times be accepted. The quality monthly magazines, such as Harper's and the Atlantic, suggest the nature of the material to be used. It will be an activity included within the curriculum as in the case of laboratory, studio, workshop and survey activities in other majors.

The magazine is edited by student members of the literature division, with the Board also including an art editor and an associate editor from each of the other majors. Faculty members of the literature division and the instructor in graphic arts will serve as advisors to the Board. The first issue includes short stories, poems, photographs and pen-and-ink drawings by students, and an article by a member of the music faculty.
