

Report of Recreation Council Meeting --June 4th, 1940.

The Recreation Council again discussed the idea of giving a party for the freshmen next Fall. Mr. Leigh has suggested that the Council sponser a picnic for the freshmen in the Recreation Building. This will immediately follow the discussion of the recreation program and the functions of the Recreation Council which will be lead by Gertrude Streeter and will take place in the Recreation Building the first Saturday after college opens in September. Mr. Leigh feels that this will give him a chance to meet the freshmen and also will give them a chance to meet the Community Council and the Recreation Council. The Council was not wholly in favor of this plan because they feel that it will segregate the freshmen rather than giving them an opportunity to meet ^{most} upper classmen. To remedy this it was suggested that the whole college be invited to the Recreation Building after supper to mix with the freshmen, and also that some sort of entertainment be supplied such as a music program by Mr. Mc Bride and Mr. Tucker. The whole Council agreed upon this suggestion which will be submitted to Mr. Leigh for approval.
