The tent will be set up on commons lawn 8/27, and will be taken down on 9/3. Pembroke Landscaping will mow Commons Lawn on 8/26.

Friday 8/23

The groundskeepers will set up our tent at the flagpole <u>for Monday 8/26 Early Student</u> Check-in.

Flagpole - Set up our 20x20 tent at the flag pole set up with flaps and opening facing Campus Safety. Also deliver 3-8' tables with12 regular chairs (not folding) and make sure there are 4 Adirondack chairs and a couple of trash cans with liners and run power to the tent.

Wednesday, August 28

9am-5:00pm - International Student Check In - Tent at Flagpole - Tables and chairs will be there already. Deliver 18 sets of bagged linen from the new electrical shop for the international students to use.

7pm - International Student Reception - Upcafe - 1-8' table

Thursday, August 29 for Friday August 30 Orientation

Orientation Set up -We will need to have the tent on commons lawn set up with 30-8' tables, with 2 chairs at each table, some tables will require 3 chairs for a total of 70 chairs and 13-60" round tables set up with 8 chairs at each and 3 for food in the center (see attached diagram for set up). The dining halls will need 15-8' tables, and 3 barbeque grills with 3 tanks (staked down), and 15 trashcans with liners, as well as several recycling totes with liners (See Angel for these). Place picnic tables on the grass area at the end of the tent, closest to the end of the world for people to sit outside if they want to. Make sure chairs and tables under the tent are in far enough, so if it rains people aren't getting wet. Leave a case of black trash bags as well. 3 Power boxes, one on Booth side and one on Dewey side of the tent and one toward the end of the world. Melissa will hang Orientation sign on the tent. Can Do will set up the 20x20 tent off to the right. Make sure that the extra stacks of chairs near Canfield are unlatched so that Student Life can get to them if they need to. Deliver 4 - 8' tables to the Student Center 3 needed for food and beverages

We will need to set up 75 chairs theatre style with a center isle facing the stage with a new podium and 5 captain's chairs. Make sure there are 2 trash cans with liners. **See attached set up**. *Kate Child

4:00pm – Start breaking down the tent on Commons Lawn and re-set with the following; 4 low carpeted risers for a stage on the Dewey side of the tent, and set up 250 chairs in arc (half circle) in two sections, and a new podium with light. Power box. Also make sure there are 4 recycling totes and 15 trash bins with liners. See attached set up for details.
