Bike Share Program

The Bennington Bike Share program is back! Bennington College community members can check out one of 10 hybrid bikes, a helmet, and a lock. Bikes are for local use, can be checked-out through the Crossett Library, and are due back the same day of check-out by the close of the Library business day.

Local Shuttle Schedule

The Green Mountain Express, a local bus service provides daily (except for Sunday) transportation locally around the towns of Bennington and North Bennington as well as to Manchester, VT, and Williamstown, MA. We have arranged for students to ride for **free** (typically \$0.50) by showing a valid Bennington ID. Shuttle schedules are posted online, in each house, and around campus. In the evenings and on Sundays, the Campus van will be available for student transport.

What happens if I lose my Bennington Card/Student ID?

If your Bennington Card is lost or stolen, and you have a declining balance on your card, you must immediately deactivate your card by logging into your user account at www.bennington.edu/Students/BenningtonCard. To replace a lost or stolen card, please come to the Office of Student Life between 11:30 am - 1:00 pm.

Where Can I Use My Bennington Card?

The Bennington Card - the official ID card of the Bennington Community - provides students access to a variety of places, including the Dining Hall, Crossett Library, MRB (general admission and use it to pay for classes), and laundry facilities. The Card can also be used like a debit card on campus and will also allow students to add money to their cards on a declining balance to be used at the Snack Bar and Bookstore, and to pay for Student Life-sponsored trips and events. Where Can I Get Cash on Campus?

- Field Work Term Prep Workshops. Week 1: Start identifying ways to use your FWT, developing goals and creating a plan to overcome barriers. This series is desgined to walk students through the FWT process. A new topic is offered each week. Students who attend all six session will be awarded 15 supplemental hours. - The weekly shuttle to Albany is available on Thursdays and Fridays; and from Albany to Bennington on Sundays and Mondays. Sign-up in the Office of Student Life by 3:00 pm on Wednesdays. The cost for a shuttle trip is \$35. Extended shuttle dates are available on the website, under Students/Quick Links/GMX Shuttle. *Please note that shuttle fees can not be billed to student accounts.*
