The Athletic Committee of the Recreation Council met on May 11, 1942.

Tennis Team: Jane Allen suggested that the way we could choose our tennis team was to have Mr. Gill, the tennis coach, and members of the Council watch the players. Also the Tennis Tournament is coming along with people playing off their matches. The team we choose this year will be recommended for next year, so that they may play matches in the fall.

Amory said she would if Jane Allen would take on the responsibility of the Tennis Tournament.

Thelma Black suggested we organize a bicycle trip with swimming at Lake Parron.

We decided that we would announce the day for the tennis finals to be played-off. The best day was Sunday, June 7th, at 3 o'clock. We hope that the Community will be interested enough to come out and watch them.
