



Bennington ACTS for Food Relief

Bennington ACTS is rolling out ACTS for Food Relief to meet the rising need of food insecurity in Bennington. Hunger has been a continuous source of stress on Bennington County residents for years. ACTS for Food Relief meets that stress head on by partnering with two local food relief organizations, HIS Pantry and Meals On Wheels, to mitigate hunger in Bennington County.

Bennington ACTS is organizing two weekly shuttles to Meals on Wheels's Bennington Cafe. The first shuttle will run every Tuesday, departing from the flagpole at 12:50 pm and arriving back on campus by 3:45 pm. The second shuttle will run every Friday, departing from the Flagpole at 10:15 am and arriving back on campus by 1:50 pm.

Bennington ACTS is organizing a shuttle to HIS Pantry every third Wednesday of the month that will depart from the Flagpole at 9:45 am and return to the College by 12:20 pm.
