Memorandum to all members of the Community

from the Educational Policies Committees

The Faculty and Student EPCs met last night to discuss arrangements for eliciting views of the community on the President's memorandum of March 3, 1969. In the hope of making significant deliberation possible for all concerned we propose the following kinds of discussions on the following schedule:

Week of March 17 (current)

- 1. Faculty divisions meet as divisions to discuss the President's memorandum and their reactions (Report March 26).
- 2. Student EPC delegates begin meetings with houses on same questions (Report March 26).

Week of March 24

- 3. Faculty divisions meet with interested students to do as above (Report March 26). (See 5.)
- 4. Student meetings continue as in 2 (Report March 26).
- 5. Division Secretaries attend joint EPC meeting Wednesday afternoon or evening (March 26) at times to be arranged to report on reactions. Student EPCs will report on house meetings.

Week of March 31

- Faculty and Student EPCs deliberate on discussions, memos, etc., Monday night (March 31) and Wednesday afternoon (April 2).
- 7. Joint EPCs or their delegates draft recommendation to faculty and students, to be distributed as soon as possible.

Week of April 7

- 8. FEPC holds Faculty Meeting on Wednesday, April 9.
- 9. Joint EPCs hold public meeting on Wednesday night, April 9.

Provision will be made for an additional meeting with the faculty or students if it proves to be necessary.
