Minutes of February 25, 1941

The Board of the Silo met on February 25th. Those members present were: Katrina Van Tassel, Joan Strong, Frances Berna, Nancy Hirose and Lucile Bloch. Those members absent: Betty Kane.

Old Business: The completed magazine was discussed and criticized with reference to material and layout.

Distribution: Time and method of distribution were discussed. It was decided that the Silo should appear on the evening of February 25th at the dinner hour; the entire Board to assist in distribution.

Re-organization: Plans for incoming board were discussed. It was asked whether under the constitution of the new magazine new positions on the board might be created. The editor explained that the constitution was flexible enough to facilitate any reconstruction.

Choice of advisor: It was suggested that there be two faculty advisors; each with his individual approach to the problem of the magazine; one to be selected more specifically for critical work and the other for help in organization. This is to be handled by the new board.

New board members: The following names were brought up for inclusion in the board. They are to be studied by the ^{literature} faculty, with selections turned back to the existing board.

On the recommendation of the faculty, approximately three will be chosen.

The new board: The new Board tentatively would be organized as follows: Editor; two assistant editors, or literary advisors; managing editor; two reporters; Art editor; two art assistants; secretary. The Board will function as follows: The Editor consolidates the whole board in one working unit; the literary advisors guide in selection of material and in critical work; the managing editor attends to collection of material, any campus publicity, distribution, and the budget; the reporters collect material and assist the managing editor; the art editor plans layout and attends to printing and is assisted by two members of her own choosing; the secretary attends to correspondence, minutes and the mailing list.

After a discussion of the present editor with the faculty, the new board will be called to order. The meeting was adjourned.
