### THE FELLOWSHIPS

The Lucille Lortel Foundation Fellowships in Theatre is a new program providing paid Field Work Term experiences at top off-Broadway theatres in New York City for Bennington students. In addition to receiving generous funding (stipends of up to \$3,500 based on need), Lucille Lortel Foundation Fellows will meet and learn as a cohort throughout the winter term, with mentorship from Bennington drama faculty and professionals in the theatre world.

Fellows will be selected by a faculty-led committee and announced October 31st.

### HOW TO APPLY

All materials due by end of day October 13, 2017. Late applications will not be accepted.

- 2) Submit the FWT Grant Application available on the College website, being sure to fill out the optional question specifying your application to the Fellowships. Those not receiving Lucille Lortel Fellowships will be considered for other FWT grants.
