Jules Olitski was born in Russia in 1922. He studied portrait painting at the National Academy of Design in New York, and has also studied with Ossip Zadkine in Paris.

His exhibitions have included one-man shows at the Iolas Gallery in 1957, at French & Co. in 1959 and 1960, and at the Poindexter Gallery in 1961 and again this year. In 1961 he won second prize at the Carnegie Internationale.

Mr. Olitski teaches at C. W. Post College, Long Island.
