

Liquor Policy in regard to the Carriage Barn.

Acting upon the recommendation of the Liquor Policy Committee, the Community Council has made a change in the College Liquor Policy as it pertains to the Carriage Barn. The old policy forbade the consumption of beer and light wines in the building except at functions sponsored by some college organization. The new policy permits individuals to bring their own beer or light wines to the Carriage Barn provided that they assume full responsibility for cleaning up when they leave.

This policy is on trial. In the Carriage Barn as well as in the house living rooms, members of the Community are expected to remember the standard which reads:

"Any objectionable conduct resulting from the use of liquor on the part of any person or group of persons in the community will not be tolerated. The community will bear in mind the difficulty of maintaining order in gatherings where liquor is being served and will arrange their parties accordingly."

This new policy does not apply on the evenings when formal or informal dances are being held, nor does it apply to functions sponsored by any college organization (divisions, etc.) At such functions no liquor may be consumed in the building except that which is served by the college.
