Robert Pinsky teaches in the graduate creative writing program at Boston University. He is poetry editor of the online journal *Slate*, and he reads poems as a regular contributor to "The NewsHour with Jim Lehrer" on PBS. Pinsky served as the thirty-ninth Poet Laureate of the United States, completing an unprecedented three terms in that post in April 2000. Pinsky's most recent collection of poetry, *Jersey Rain*, was published by Farrar, Straus & Giroux in April 2000. His *The Figured Wheel: New and Collected Poems 1966-1996*, published by Farrar, Straus & Giroux in 1996, was nominated for the Pulitzer Prize in poetry and also received the Lenore Marshall Award and the Ambassador Book Award of the English Speaking Union.
