Community Meeting

There was a meeting of the community on Wednesday night, November 22. Mr. Leigh presided.

Mr. Leigh explained the arrangement the trustees of the College and of the Mt. Anthony Country Club agreed upon for the use of the club. Beginning next fall there will be universal student membership without extra charge. The money will be taken out of the tuition fee. For the rest of this year there will be a charge of \$1.50 for all those wishing to join the club. Membership tickets may be purchased from Miss Jones. If cards are lost there will be a charge of 25¢ for another one. The club will have facilities for winter sports with no extra charge for skiing instruction. The clubhouse will be open and tea served. Guest fees for golf remain the same and there will be a small charge for winter sports.

Mr. Leigh also explained about the fee for non-resident work in the senior division. This work will be decided on an educational, not a financial, basis.

It was announced that all classes will be held up until one o'clock on Wednesday, November 29 and will begin again Monday morning, December 4. The E. P. C. and faculty agreed last year that classes should continue up to the last hour before a holiday and begin immediately after the vacation.

An appeal was made for Thanksgiving baskets. Several suggestions were made and it was decided to give up meat two extra days of different weeks thus saving \$50.00 to be used for baskets.
