### DRIVING REGULATIONS

## A. LICENCES

- 1) No member of the Community may drive nor keep a car at college until she has filed an application for a college license at the Records Office. After testing the student, the Central Committee makes its recommendations to the Community Council, which has authority to grant licenses or to revoke them upon evidence of irresponsible driving or failure to observe the following regulations:
  - a. Students may not lend nor borrow cars, except in cases of extreme emergency. In such cases an Emergency Slip must be obtained from the House Chairman and signed by the Chairman of both the borrower and the lender, and by the borrower and lender themselves.
  - b. Faculty members may not borrow student cars nor lend their cars to the students.
  - c. All cars must report to the Records Office any accident they are in while in residence at the College.
  - d. All arrests must be reported to the Records Office.

# B. TRAFFIC AND PARKING REGULATIONS

- 1) The speed limit on campus is 30 mph on the main driveway and 20 mph on the other roads, with reduced speed between the houses and at all intersections.
- 2) Riding on running boards is not allowed, both as a safety precaution and because of state law.
- 3) Cars may not be driven in front of the Commons building, nor be parked in front of Fairview.
- 4) Parking areas available are as follows:
  - a. Space on east side of campus, for residenst of east side only and their guests.
  - b. Space on west side of campus, for residents of west side and visitors.
  - c. Annex to west parking space, for general use and employees.

d. Space behind the Barn, for general use.

- e. Small area east of the library for cars going to Cricket Hill.
- f. Space west of sculpture studio, for people using sculpture studio and drama studios and for residents of the Brooder.

g. Limited space in Commons delivery entrance, with temporary (fifteen minute) parking until 6:00 PM only.

h. Area west of Fairview and norht of Carriage Barn.

- i. Space north of Commons by policeman's booth, for general and night use.
- 5) Cars of residents may be parked on the east side of the driveways between the student houses, subject to these conditions:

# 5) cont.

- a. Cars may not at any time obstruct the driveways, nor be left in front of fire hydrants, nor obstruct any walks or entrances.
- b. A barrier will be placed across the roadways at 7:00 PM. Any student driving between the houses after that hour must replace the barrier.
- c. Cars must be removed from the driveways by 10:00 PM.
- 6) Cars coming to the College after 11:00 PM must be parked in the area near the policeman's booth unless they are to be parked for the night, in which case they may be driven to the proper area. Those people who for any reason (because of bad weather or luggage) need to go to the houses temporarily, will be permitted to do so.
