5.Joan fee: $\$ 20$ per print, or at least enax $\$ 200$ as minimum fee
6. In the cass of a purchases you had said the photographer's cut should be $90 \%$ but we're still investigating this bviously it's not a gallery situation but it doesn* seem fair that we only get $5 \%$ either.
7. All curatirial decisions about the show are ours.
