

FROM McCARTHY FOR PRESIDENT:

Canvassers are desperately needed in Indiana this weekend.

Below is a schedule for transportation to Indiana.

Thursday: A bus will leave for Indianapolis from Elsie's restaurant near Harvard Square in Cambridge at 1:00. It will return by 4:00 Tuesday. Transportation, food, and lodging are free of charge.

Thursday night and all day Friday: There will be stand-by flights leaving from Logan Airport in Boston. Round-trip fare will be \$10-\$15. The Brookline McCarthy for President Office has arranged to pay the balance of the fare. You can return whenever you want.

Friday at 6:00 P.M.: A bus will leave McCarthy Headquarters, 503 State Street, Schenectady, N.Y., for Fort Wayne, Ind, and will return about 1:30 A.M. on Wednesday. Food and lodging are free; transportation costs will be divided among the volunteers. Though it may cost \$15 round-trip, the probability is that \$8 will be the maximum. Transportation to Schenectady and living arrangements for the remainder of Wednesday morning are available.

Living arrangements in Indiana are available for anyone that wishes to drive.
