GUEST ARTIST TONY HEPBURN TO SPEAK AT BENNINGTON COLLEGE

BENNINGTON, VT—Bennington College will present a lecture by guest artist and ceramist Tony Hepburn on Thursday, October 13, at 7:00 p.m. in Room B-205 in the Visual and Performing Arts Center on the Bennington College campus. The public is invited to attend.

Hepburn is head of ceramics and artist-in-residence at the Cranbrook Academy of Art. His recent solo exhibitions include the Revolution Gallery in Detroit, the Cranbrook Academy of Art Museum, the Dorothy Weiss Gallery in San Francisco, the Farrell Collection in Washington, D.C., and Esther Saks Gallery in Chicago, among many others. He has given lectures or workshops at numerous institutions, among them the Boston Museum, Anderson Ranch, the American Craft Museum, the University of Illinois, Bristol Polytechnic, the Art Institute of Chicago, Cooper-Hewitt Museum, and the Rhode Island School of Design. Hepburn has received two New York State Council on the Arts Fellowships, a National Endowment for the Arts grant, the Virginia Groot Foundation Award, and the Koopman Distinguished Chair in Fine Arts from the Hartford School of Art.
