

Report of Recreation Council Meeting --April 30, 1940.

The problem of furnishing the Coach House in time for the formal dance has arisen. Miss Shelly reported that furniture is being designed and made as fast as possible but she feels sure that it will not be completed by May 18. She also informed the council that it is possible that the building will be in the process of being painted at the time. In view of these facts it was suggested that the dance be held in the theatre instead of the Coach House. However, the dance committee decided they would rather have the dance in the Couch House without much furniture instead of the theatre. They will request that the painting be done after the dance or before that weekend.

The dance committee again recommends the same liquor policy as followed on the last weekend.

It was announced that square dancing instruction will begin on Wednesday in the Coach House for beginners and it is hoped that in a few weeks the students will know the dances well enough to do them with the faculty, in which case parties will be arranged for this purpose.
