I know Terry wants 1981, but you should check weach photographer to make certain.

For your choice of chotos to go w Sally's article, I feel lukewarm about Trillium and Imperceptable Elongation, since I feel they are good who documentary photos but not super(b) photos. The others-3 Seascapes, Meat Joy, Site, and Word Words, will be good.
