Dear Mr. Olitski:

In talking with Mr. Poindexter I understand that you and Mrs. Olitski are planning to drive up here with your paintings next Monday afternoon, arriving here in the evening. I have therefore had the college guest suite reserved for you Monday night.

The college is situated a few miles northwest of Bennington. Bennington is on U. S. Route 7, and you should keep on this route past the village of Bennington until you come to a stop light where the road divides, the right-hand road continuing on Route 7 and the road straight ahead leading you to the college. After a drive of about three miles you will come to the college gates. Proceed through the gates along the road for about a half or three quarters of a mile until you come to a left-hand turn. Proceed along this road, which winds to the left, until you come to a large brick building (on the right) with a tower. This is the Commons building where the guest suite is located. The switchboard is on the ground floor of this building, and there will be someone there who will direct you to the guest suite. The switchboard closes at 11 o'clock; therefore, if you should arrive after that time, please stop at the watchman's booth, just before you come to the Commons building, and he will escort you to your room. If you feel any confusion in finding your way here, please do not hesitate to call my house when you get to Bennington. The telephone number is Bennington 2-5956.

We are all very pleased that arrangements for your show seem to be working out so well and look forward with much pleasure to meeting you and Mrs. Olitski. Please be sure to call me if you find it difficult to cope with my directions for getting here.
