Minutes of Meeting  
June 7, 1972

1. Minutes approved.
2. The following Tutorial Plans were approved: M. Broderick - (composition & Chamber music), Elizabeth Cohen (Acoustics), Baird Hersey (composition, piano & Voice), Lucette (voice), Ralph Mack (Saxophone), Debby Rohr (composition), Schloss (Piano Improvisation).
3. The Tentative Plan of Robin Stark was approved and the Confirmation of Plans of Kathryn Tiffany, Martha Broderick and Stanley Scott was approved.
4. Yasmin Aga Khan's concert date has been set for November 29th.
5. Gunnar Schonbeck will listen to Tom Matthews to determine whether his fender bass education with Chris Bishop should apply toward his Music I work.
6. After a short discussion of the candidates for Gunnar Schonbeck's sabbatical replacement it was decided to call a mass meeting of woodwind playing students for this Tuesday at 5 PM to solicit their opinion about the 6 candidates. It was agreed that we would ask for two half-time candidates; the applicants having expressed their willingness to accept such an arrangement.
