

Report of Recreation Council Meeting - Sept. 30, 1940.

The Student Treasurer reported on the decision of the Community Chest Committee concerning the drive for soup to send to refugees. The Chest Committee is willing to sponsor the drive but would like to know more of the details before the drive is begun. The Chest Committee recommends that soup cans be placed in obvious places around campus to serve as containers for voluntary contributions rather than having the house collectors do the job, because they are already overburdened. A thorough investigation of the situation will be made before the drive is begun.

The Entertainment Committee announced plans for a spelling bee to be held on October 8th.

The Dance Committee reported that the informal informal dance was very successful and no problems arose.

The rest of the discussion was chiefly concerned with the arrangement of furniture in the Carriage Barn.
