Helen Mirra '91 makes minimalist work in a variety of media including film, sound, text, and sculpture, informed by referents including geology, ecology, and pragmatist philosophy. Her work has been exhibited in gallery and museum exhibitions worldwide, including the 50th Venice Biennale and solo shows at the Whitney Museum, the Berkeley Art Museum and the DAAD Galerie, Berlin. Mirra is currently Associate Professor of Visual and Environmental Studies at Harvard University.

A gallery exhibition of Mirra's work, located in Usdan Gallery, VAPA, opens on Tuesday, April 8, 2008. The exhibition will be on display through Friday, May 2, 2008.
