The Board approved the A. S. U. proposal for a used-book sale.

Sandwich Concession

Two Theatre Studio boys, Hal Jamieson and Chandler Cowles, proposed to make sandwiches to sell in the Store; the Board decided against this since most former dealings with the Theatre Studio boys have been found most unsatisfactory.

Mrs. Park asked if she could make sandwiches out of home made bread to sell in the Store or in the Recreation Building. The Board voted to grant this request.

Recreation Building

The Board decided to give a free tea to open the Store in the Recreation Building formally. The date was set for April 14th at 4:00 p.m. Miss Steven, Katrina Voorhees, Margaret Ramsey and Frances Berna were appointed a committee to arrange the tea.

The hours the Branch Store is to be open were discussed but no definite decision was made.

Mr. Nelson was unable to pay his store bill, which amounts to over \$20. He wants to retire so that he can put the \$10 he would get towards his bills. Miss Steven was given power to act on this as she wishes.
