- Our first Company reading will be on Monday, 20 September, in Room D-208 immediately following the Division-wide meeting to elect an S.E.P.C. representative. The entire Company must be present; I would also like for the Designer to attend, and any persons who know at this moment that they will be working on the show. We will have some paper work to accomplish, I have a few words to say about Pirandello and the play, and then we will have a read-through.
- 4. Each of you should be aware that almost everyone is on stage throughout the play. That is not to say that everyone must be at every rehearsal, but you will have a heavy rehearsal schedule.
- 5. The rehearsal schedule for the week will be announced on Monday evening, and then posted on the board. CHECK THE BOARD DAILY. I can tell you that you will have the weekend of Friday, 24 September through Sunday, 26 September, off. After that, everyone is on call every weekend, and at least part of Long Weekend. (You will, however, know whether you are actually called before the weekend, so you may plan accordingly.)
