#### **Quarantine Cookbook**

As the Bennington community social distances during the COVID-19 pandemic, virtual Wellbeing Assistant Soumya Shailendra '21 <u>is compiling</u> a community cookbook to foster healthy eating habits during quarantine. ## **PFAS Findings**

Research conducted by a team of Bennington researchers—including David Bond, Janet Foley, Tim Schroeder, and students in their Understanding PFOA course—on soil and surface water samples from neighborhoods around the Norlite plant in Cohoes, NY, has found that Aqueous Fire Fighting Foam (AFFF) burned at the plant <u>released</u> <u>PFAS</u> into the surrounding areas. Their findings have been widely publicized in regional and national outlets,

including <u>Chemical & Engineering</u> <u>News</u>, <u>Politico</u>, and <u>Bloomberg Law</u>. As a result of their preliminary findings, Senator Charles Schumer <u>has contacted</u> federal agencies, calling for a more substantial study of emissions at this hazardous waste facility.

#### **Murphy Receives NEH Grant**

Brian Michael Murphy <u>has been awarded</u> a \$6,000 summer stipend from the National Endowment for the Humanities for his project "Preserving Data in America, from the Depression to the Digital Age." This grant will support Murphy as he finishes his book, *We the Dead: Preserving Data at the End of the World*, which is under contract with the University of North Carolina Press.

#### **Critical Language Scholarship**

Congratulations to Megan Swanson '21, who <u>was selected</u> as a finalist for the Critical Language Scholarship, an intensive overseas language and cultural immersion program for American students enrolled at US colleges and universities. Though the 2020 program was suspended for this summer, we wanted to recognize Megan's accomplishment as a finalist for this highly selective program, which only accepts approximately 10% of its 5,000+ applicants. Tatiana Abatemarco and Erin McKenny <u>hosted a panel discussion</u> with Lisa MacDougall of Mighty Food Farm, Jesse Pyles of Smokey House, and Jesse McDougall of Studio Hill Farm regarding the specific actions being taken in the Bennington region to maintain a robust local food supply during the pandemic and beyond.
