Report of Recreation Council Meeting -- May 21, 1940.

Mr. Leigh was preasent at the Recreation Meeting of May 21st.

The Council discussed with him the need for a definite response from the students for the formal dance and also a guarentee. It was decided that tickets should be sold a month in advance in order to obtain this guarentee.

There is felt also a need for more informal dances which would be smaller and very informal. Mr Leigh suggested that a reproducing machine could be purchased if the Council decided to have weekly dances in the Recreation Building -- as this machine is also needed for other purposes.

In regard to the activities tickets, it was decided to discontinue them because there is a desire not to have any recreational institution within the college.

The formal dance was reported very successful this year and there is no deficit.

The Recreation Council finds it impossible to schedule a square dance successfully thes spring, so it was decided to wait and have one next fall.
